Salmon Brook would like to address concerns about COVID-19 and how it affects you and your pets. According to the American Veterinary Medical Association, the primary concern is for human health. The virus causes flu-like symptoms in people, including cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell. Multiple international health organizations have indicated that pets and other domestic animals are not considered at risk for contracting COVID-19. If there is someone in your household that is symptomatic, they should limit their exposure to the pets in the house as a precaution to prevent transmission of the disease, by contact, to another person. As always, animal owners should continue to include pets and other animals in their emergency preparedness planning, including keeping a supply of food and medications on hand. We are allocating prescriptions and food to a 30-day supply during this pandemic.

Prior to June 1st, we are only seeing cases that require medical attention or pets that are due for a rabies vaccination. Beginning June 1st, we will start to schedule routine visits for vaccinations, boarding and grooming. In addition to Saturday hours of 8-5pm, we will be open until 6:00pm Monday through Friday the week of May 11th. Beginning May 18th, we will be open until 7:00pm and on June 1st we will be back to normal hours Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 8:00pm and Saturdays 8-5pm.

We will only be offering curbside service for the foreseeable future. At this time, we will not be allowing clients into the building. One exception is to be with your pet during euthanasia. When you arrive, please park in a space that has a numbered sign. Call our office and tell the receptionist what space you are parked in. We will come out to you. Please wear a mask and stay in your car. We cannot take any notes from you and we will use one of our leashes on your dog. We ask that if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, as mentioned above, please reschedule any non-urgent appointments. Non-urgent appointments would include annual exams for healthy pets and recheck exams for ailments that are clearly resolving. If you need a prescription refilled, we can mail it to you if you prefer.
